The New York GOLD CLASSIC is open to all registered Haflingers showing pleasure style. Each horse/rider/driver combination will be given its own exhibitor number. Safe, proper, pleasure type tack and attire required in all classes. All horses and exhibitors are expected to perform at their appropriate levels. Two sets of ribbons to 6th place will be awarded in each class (timed, dressage, trail & leadline, one set). One BEST of SHOW Performance Award, as jointly decided by both judges, will be presented at the conclusion of Sunday's classes. This award is not point based. Additional awards will be given as sponsorships warrant. NYS Law requires any youth under 14 years of age to wear an ASTM F1163 helmet. Negative Coggins dated 8/18/07 or later is required. **NEW: RABIES CERTIFICATES DATED 8/18/2007 OR LATER ARE ALSO REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES.** Exhibitors may arrive anytime after noon on 8/14. Show office will be open 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. on 8/15 and will re-open at 7 a.m. on 8/16 & at 8 a.m. on 8/17 unless posted otherwise. Patterns will be posted no later than one hour prior to those classes requiring patterns (i.e. fence, gymkhana, driven obstacles). Prior to receiving an exhibitor's number all owners must show proof of registration, negative Coggins, Rabies certificate AND (if from outside New York) a 30-day Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Interstate Health Certificate) for each horse entering the grounds. Driven classes guided by ADS rules. Dressage classes guided by USDF rules (Note: See JR/YR age change). All handler/exhibitors of stallions must be 18 years or older. Horses under two years of age may NOT enter any ridden or driven classes. Bedding is available on a pre-order, pre-paid basis and will be at your stall upon arrival (see enclosed form). Exhibitors may show off trailer for an additional fee of \$15 per day. Grounds management prohibits overnight stabling of any horses on trailers. Camping \$30 per night (applies to RV's, tents, automobiles, etc....if you are sleeping on the grounds it is considered camping). Camping is first come, first serve and must be pre-paid. All paid campers will receive a pass. Food available on grounds.

Leadline riders 12 years & under with experienced handler at least 16 years old. Leadline exhibitors may not enter any other classes. Youth and JR/YR age is 18 years & under as of show date. Walk/Trot riders MAY only enter those classes designated as walk/trot (W/T) or walk/jog (W/J) and may not cross enter into canter classes. Note: Jumping classes #68 & 69 permit trotting (required for W/T entries, optional for W/T/C entries). Exhibitors in Classes #70 thru 74 must canter. Same horse/rider combination in crossrail classes (#68 & 69) may not enter classes 70-74. Jack/Jackie Benny class is limited to riders age 50 and older. Single & multiple turnouts show together. Dressage exhibitors may compete in 2 consecutive dressage divisions only. Total maximum of 2 dressage tests allowed per horse. Readers permitted at Intro & Training Levels only. Acceptable dressage bridles include flash, drop, figure 8 or cavesson nosebands with snaffle bits only. No leg bandages or boots allowed during dressage test. Dressage times available after August 1st. The \$100 GO FOR THE GOLD in hand classes are also doubled judged, paying out a total of \$200 in each of those classes (\$100 to each judge's first place pick). Must enter respective halter class in order to participate in \$100 halter classes. Must sign up for \$100 classes PRIOR to exhibiting in respective halter classes. Tri-State Triple Challenge qualifying classes are underlined. All entries in those classes are automatically entered in the Challenge. All out-of-state horses require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Negative Coggins required for all horses. RABIES vaccination certificates are also REQUIRED. Coggins and rabies should both be dated 8/18/07 or later. Leashed/kenneled DOGS are permitted. All dogs must also have proof of current rabies vaccination. Grounds offer one indoor and 4 outdoor rings, permanent stabling, restrooms w/showers, camping facilities, food booth and outdoor pavilion. SMOKING NOT PERMITTED in or near barn/stables. A technical delegate (TD) will be available for rules clarification. Exhibitors may direct questions to the TD (not the judges) at any time throughout show hours. Show Management reserves the right to excuse any individual displaying misconduct. Judges' decisions are final.

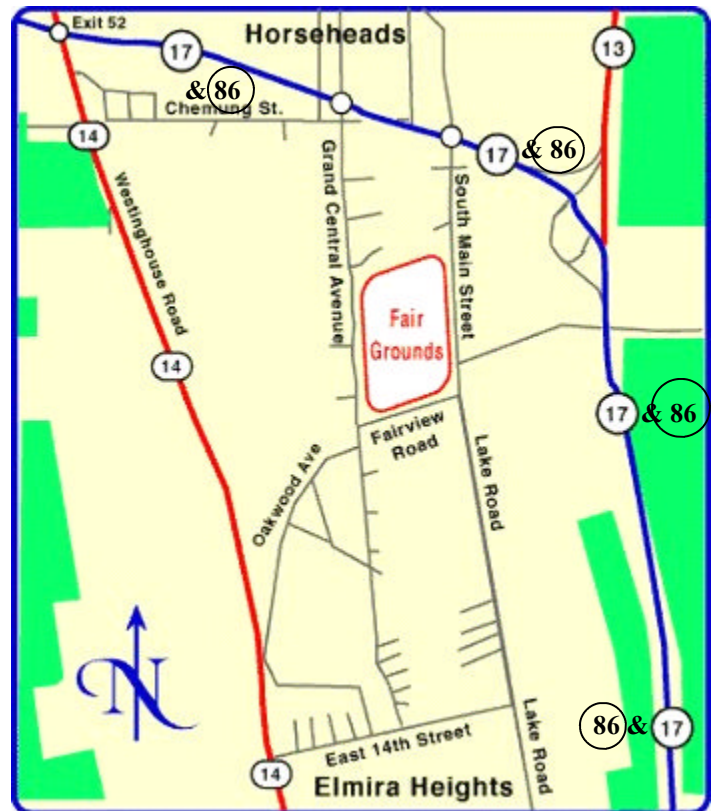
